Looking for something to do this summer? Be on the lookout for 4-H summer workshops. This summer, Northampton 4-H is partnering with the Eastern Shore Soil and Water Conservation District educator to offer 2, two-day day agricultural day camps at the Barrier Islands Center in Machipongo. The first camp will be July 27 and 28 from 9 am to 12pm, for ages 5 - 8. Cost is \$20/camper. The second camp will take place August 1 and 2 from 9am to 3pm. Cost is \$40/camper. During the camp youth will make agriculture related crafts, visit with animals including cows and sheep, learn more about Virginia Agriculture, and participate in a wide range of fun hands-on activities.
