The event will consist of teams of two hunters with an adult division and youth division. The youth division will be any youth 15 and under, they will have to be accompanied by an adult 18 and older. The adult cannot participate for that team. Adult and youth combined teams can compete but will be scored in the adult class. Scoring will consist of the highest score being the heaviest weight of harvested squirrels, each division will have 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. You are allowed 6 squirrels per person with the maximum being 12 squirrels for the team. The hunt must take place on the day of the tournament, you can use any legal method to harvest the squirrel and on any legal hunting land (private, public lands). Weigh-in will start at 4:30pm the day of the event at the Exmore Moose Lodge in the Seafood Building around back. Cutoff time will be 6:30.
